




PERFECT BOUND BROCHURES INNER COVER READ-OVERS

If set up incorrectly, text/images which cross over the inner covers and text pages will appear to 'overlap' and not line up due to the perfect binding process.

IFC – first page or last page – IBC, will appear to 'overlap' and not line up due to no hinge allowance included on the artwork.

Images need to be moved 6mm to the left and right respectively within its bounding/image box so that they visually meet at the correct point where the pages join.



Follow these guidelines or your file supplied will result in a finish like this.

Each Image needs to be moved 6mm left and 6mm right respectively.

Although it looks odd, when flat form the two halves will line up correctly when the book is bound as shown below.
